The purpose of this symposium is to promote Root and Tuber Crops production, utilisation, adoption, upscaling and marketing opportunities through:

- 2. provision of an opportunity for research scientists in Africa to present results to the world scientific community
- 3. promotion and encouragement of research, extension, training and donor and policy support of tropical root and tuber crops
- 4. Strengthening of linkages of recent methodological approaches to research and development to enhance technology transfer on root and tuber crops
- 5. development of new researchable issues and proposals for institutional collaboration for root and tuber crops
- 6. enhancing opportunities for diversification in the utilisation and commercialisation of products from Root and Tuber Crops

# **Publication of Papers**

Papers presented at the conference will be published in a volume tentatively titled "Proceedings of the 9<sup>th</sup> Triennial ISTRC-AB Symposium 2004".

# Paper Submission Deadlines

All abstracts should be submitted by 21<sup>st</sup> July 2004. Full copies of accepted papers should be submitted by 15<sup>th</sup> August 2004.

# Manuscript Requirements

Papers must be in English, typed on A4 size paper and not longer than twelve (12) double-spaced typewritten pages including tables and figures. Pages should be numbered consecutively with author's names and a running title at the top of each page. Hard copies of all manuscripts should be submitted in duplicate and diskette or electronic copies in MS. Word for Windows 97, 98 or 2000.

# Title, Author and Running Heads

The name of the author to present the paper should be underlined. Include telephone, e-mail and fax numbers for ease of communication. The title of the paper should represent the content of the article and briefly identify the subject, indicate the purpose of the study and give important high impact words. The title should also run on the top of each page.

# Scientific and Common Names

Scientific names must be given for each organism, followed by the author, the first time the name is used. Names of the species and genera must be italicised. For other taxa, the first letter is capitalised but the names are not italicised. After the first mention, the generic name may be abbreviated provided it does not appear at the beginning of a sentence. The use of pesticide names should follow standard convention and the correct chemical name given the first time the pesticide is mentioned with a disclaimer. Measurements should be in S.I. units.

#### Parts of the Manuscript

The paper should have the following sections: Abstract, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Acknowledgement and References. Illustration(s) (Tables etc.) should be attached at the end of the paper.

# **References in Text**

References in text should be by author(s) and year. Authors with more than one publication per year should have a letter following their names after the second publication. If more than two authors are listed, the names of the first author should be given followed by "*et al.*".

#### Illustrations

No provisions shall be made for altering illustrations after submission. The illustrations should be drawn on the same size as the page and be clearly labelled.

#### Literature Cited

Names of journals should be spelled out in their entirety, followed by the Volume Number (and Issue Number where available). Page numbers should be inclusive and follow a colon after the Volume Number. For books, give the title, the city of publication and the name of the publisher. Do not include the number of pages unless you are referring to a section of the book.

#### **Poster Session**

There will be several poster sessions during the Symposium. Participants who wish to present posters should indicate their preference when submitting their abstracts. All posters should fit into a poster board measuring 1682 x 2378 mm. The posters should:

- be legible from a distance of 2 metres
- ➢ be simple, informative, visually appealing and attractive
- be easy to read and understand with relevant legend(s)
- contain text and illustrative matter harmoniously combined to produce an effective presentation
- $\succ$  tell the complete story.
